RESOLUTION NO. 2025-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE STATE OF
LOUISIANA AND THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE RELATING TO THE RE-
DESIGNATION OF THE LAFAYETTE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION
AS THE ACADIANA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AND ITS
GOVERNANCE.

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14(C) of the 1974 Constitution of the State of Louisiana and LSA-R.S. 33:1324, et seq. provide that, for a public purpose, public entities, parishes, municipalities and political subdivisions may engage in and make cooperative endeavor/intergovernmental agreements between themselves for specific purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Youngsville has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Youngsville to enter into an intergovernmental agreement by and between the State of Louisiana relating to the re-designation of the Lafayette Metropolitan Planning Organization as the Acadiana Metropolitan Planning Organization and its governance; and

NOW, THEREOFRE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Youngsville, Louisiana, does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, etc., which may be necessary for the City of Youngsville and the Acadiana Metropolitan Planning Organization intergovernmental agreement.
