A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSVILLE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE IN THE CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE RETIREMENT OF CITY EMPLOYEES NOT CURRENTLY PARTICIPATING IN A STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE YOUNGSVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT (YVFD)TO DO THE SAME ONCE THE BY-LAWS ARE REVIEWED AND AMENDED

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of Youngsville, governing authority of the City of Youngsville, that the City of Youngsville wishes to improve the retirement benefits for all employees of the City of Youngsville that are currently not participating in a State retirement system; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council also wish to include the YVFD to take advantage of these same benefits conditioned on the current By-Laws being amended to change the make-up of the Board of Directors which now only is comprised of employees of the Fire Department said revisions to be reviewed by the Mayor and Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Youngsville hereby approves an increase in the retirement benefits for the City of Youngsville employees who are not participating in a State Retirement System which will include the current 5% contribution and an additional match of up to 5% for a total of 10%; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, this same benefit will be offered to the Youngsville Volunteer Fire Department conditioned on the amendment to the current YVFD Bylaws and the makeup of the members of the Board.
