Good morning,

Mr. Brady Joshua Thibodeaux is applying for a Federal Firearms License to become a dealer and manufacturer in firearms from the address of 333 Forest Grove Dr in Youngsville, LA. The license will allow for the manufacture and sale of firearms and ammunition, as well as the repair of firearms, from the licensed premises. Can you please advise if there are any zoning restrictions that would prevent the manufacture of firearms, sale of firearms, repair of firearms, or sale of ammunition from this address?

Please note the following points to clarify your questions regarding ATF licensing.

- The Federal Firearms Regulation of § 478.11 defines a firearms manufacturer as “Any person engaged in the business of manufacturing firearms or ammunition for purposes of sale or distribution.”
- Once ATF issues a Federal Firearms License, the covered activities are allowed to be performed at any time during the validity of the license.
- All permitted firearm activity must occur at the address that is licensed as the business premises of the Federal Firearms Licensee. In addition, the customer is required to visit the premises to receive the firearms that they purchased.
- The Federal Firearms Licensee must obtain all applicable State, Local, and Federal licensing required to business such as sales tax registrations and occupational licensing.
