A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT WITH THE PARISH OF LAFAYETTE REGARDING FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF LOUISIANA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TO OFFSET ELIGIBLE COSTS INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH SEVERE STORMS AND TORNADOS FROM MAY 20 - JUNE 9, 2024, SUBJECT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER JML 24-72

WHEREAS, the City of Youngsville, of the Parish of Lafayette, Louisiana, experienced severe storms and tornados from May 20 - June 9, 2024; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a contract by and between the Parish of Lafayette and the State of Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, the Parish is to receive funding to offset up to seventy-five (75%) percent of: (i) eligible costs that the Parish (and/or the municipalities within the Parish) incurred responding to and recovering from the severe storms and tornado events, for which the Governor declared a state of emergency in Executive Order Number JML 24-72; and (ii) costs associated with eligible Emergency Protective Measures; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the payment of recovery costs to Youngsville, Youngsville and the Parish must enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement to set forth the obligations of the Parish and Youngsville in connection with the State funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Youngsville does hereby authorize the Mayor to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Parish of Lafayette regarding funding from the State of Louisiana Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness to offset eligible costs incurred in connection with severe storms and tornados from May 20 - June 9, 2024, subject to Executive Order # JML 24-72.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documentation associated with this agreement.
